

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. Run under British Dressage Rules. Making an entry for a competition constitutes acceptance of the rules.
2. Wokingham Equestrian Centre, the organisers, their representatives or helpers do not accept liability for injury, damage or loss suffered by spectators, competitors, their horses, grooms, friends, vehicles or property, however caused, and under any circumstances, except proven negligence of the organisers.
3. Any withdrawals made before the close of entries will be refunded 50% of the entry fee. No refunds given after close of entries.
4. In the event of a competition being cancelled, £1.50 per horse, per class will be retained to cover admin costs.
5. After the close of entries a change of horse or rider is allowed, but not both.
6. Organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry without reason, to cancel or alter any class, section or competition as they see fit without needing to give a reason.
7. The judge's and organisers decision is final. Any objections must be lodged with the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident and supported by a £10 deposit, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
8. It is the competitors responsibility to call for their times. Any competitors who do not call for their times will be deemed to have withdrawn and their time will be given to another competitor. A refund will not be given in these circumstances.
9. Correct riding attire and gloves must be worn by all competitors. Hard hats conforming to BS EN 1384 or PAS 015 must be worn when mounted.
10. No dogs.
11. Lunging is not allowed.
12. Horses must be four years or over.
13. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
14. Competitors and other visitors are not allowed in the W.E.C. livery yard. Toilets are situated outside the yard. Follow the signs.
15. The organisers have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
16. Any accidents must be reported to the secretary and an accident report completed.
17. Gates must be kept closed at all times.
18. Please put your litter in the bin's provided or take it home.
